George C. Koehler, 85, of Rock Island, Ill., formerly of Nevada, died Tuesday, Feb. 2, 1999, at Trinity Medical Center West Campus in Rock Island.

Graveside services will be held Thursday, Feb. 4, at 11 a.m. at Memorial Park Cemetery in Rock Island.

Koehler was born Feb. 24, 1913, in Kansas City, Mo., to Fred and Bertha Koehler.

He married Wilma L. Southern on March 17, 1935, in Marshalltown. Koehler had worked as a carpenter through Carpenters Union Local 166, Rock Island, retiring in 1973. In earlier years he had worked for the State of Iowa Highway Commission.
