Gladys Lambert Leui, 94, of Nevada, died Thursday at Story County Medical Center in Nevada of kidney failure. Funeral services will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday at Central Presbyterian Church in Nevada with the Rev. Larry Mitchell officiating. The body will be cremated. Burial will be in Ft. McPherson National Cemetery in Maxwell, Neb.

Gladys Lambert Leui was born Dec. 12, 1906, in Wheatland, Wyo., the daughter of Frank and Ella (King) Lambert. She was a teacher in Broken Bow, Neb., and taught Indian children in South Dakota. She married Foster A. Leui in Wyoming in 1938 and moved to Nevada. She was a member

of Central Presbyterian Church and various conservation groups. She attended Iowa State University after her husband's death in 1978.

She is survived by two nephews.

She was preceded in death by her husband, two brothers and one sister.

Visitation will be from 12:30 to 2 p.m. Tuesday at Central Presbyterian Church. A memorial fund has been established.
