Beatrice Legvold, 79, of Huxley, died due to complications of Alzheimers Thursday at Carroll Health Center in Carroll. Funeral services are 10:30 a.m. Monday at Fjeldberg Lutheran Church in Huxley, with the Rev. Forrest Chaffee officiating. Burial will be in Fjeldberg Church Cemetery in rural Huxley.

Beatrice Legvold was born in Garden Grove, the daughter of Murice and Harriett (Schooler) Brown. She had lived in Huxley since 1948. On June 6, 1948, she married Ole Legvold in Garden Grove. Prior to marriage, she was a teacher in Garner, Dawson and Grand Junction. She was a member of Fjeldberg Lutheran Church, where she taught Sunday School, and of Elizabeth Circle, the sewing club and PEO.

Survivors include her husband; two sons, Terry Legvold of Orlando, Fla., and Jim Legvold of Forth Worth, Texas; a daughter, Linda Paulson of Carroll; five grandchildren; and a brother, Thomas J. Brown of Fairfield.

She was preceded in death by her parents and a granddaughter, Jill Legvold.
