Cyril Francis Lengeling, 88 of Collins, IA, died Tuesday, October 2, 2007 at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames, IA.

Cyril, the son of Joseph and Josephine (Olberding) Lengeling, was born in Breda, IA on October 16, 1918. He graduated from St. Bernard High School in Breda and attended Iowa State University. He married Roberta Jean Kimberly of Collins. Cyril farmed in Jasper, Story and Polk County. He was a veteran having served in WWII with the US Army Air Corps as a radio operator in the Philippines.
