Geneva Ida Schulz Link was born May 3, 1916, near Great Bend, KS, to Edwin and Ida Burgtorf Schulz. At the age of four she moved with her family to northern Arkansas and attended school at Iuka. She became a Christian at the age of 17 at a Brush Arbor Evangelistic Meeting and was baptized in the North Fork River.

In 1936, Geneva moved to Iowa with her parents.

On April 18, 1940, she was united in marriage to Richard Link in the Farrar church. They farmed north of Farrar. She was a member of the Farrar United Methodist Church and taught the Youth Sunday School Class for 25 years. Geneva loved to cook, entertain, garden, and share her produce with family and neighbors.
