Dies At Age 73;

Mrs. Myrlta B. Richeson, 73, 544 N. 3rd St., died Friday evening at Evangelical Hospital. She had been in failing health for five years.

She was born Oct. 4, 1889, in Marshall County, daughter of John W. and Amanda Long, and was married Sept. 16, 1908, to Daniel W. Richeson. They farmed in the State Center and Melbourne area until retiring to Marshalltown in 1946.

MR. RICHESON died Jan. 20, 1955, and she was also preceded in death by two sons and one sister.

MRS. RICHESON was reared in the Rhodes area and was graduated from Rhodes High School. She was a member of Crystal Chapter No. 11, OES, at Rhodes, and first Methodist Church, Mothers Club of the American Legion Auxiliary and the WSCS in Marshalltown.
