LEWIS C. LONG

Lewis C. Long, a former mayor of Lake Helen, died at 4:45 yesterday afternoon at Fish Memorial Hospital where he had been a patient for a single day. He had been in failing health for some time.

Mr. Long, who was born in Kirkland, Ohio, Feb. 21, 1883, came to Volusia County 44 years ago and for many years was associated in business with his father-in-law, E. W. Bond. Active in community affairs, he had, in former years, served Lake Helen both as a commissioner and as mayor. He was also a member of Lake Helen Rifle Club.

Surviving are: his widow, Mrs. Minerva Bond Long, Lake Helen; five grandchildren; and a brother, H. H. Long, Los Angeles, Calif.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. tomorrow at St. Barnabas Episcopal Church, with the Rev. LeRoy Lawson, rector of the church, officiating. Burial will be at Oakdale Cemetery.

Serving as pallbearers will be Tommy Viers, Homer Knapp, Justine Williams, Laurence Hubbard, Ralph Handyside and Riley Wilkins.
