

ETHEL IMOGENE LUIING

Ethel Imogene Luing, 91, of Colo IA, died of a stroke Saturday, November 7, 1987 at State Center Manor, State Center IA.

Funeral services were held at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday morning, Nov. 10, 1987, at the Cooper-Ryan Funeral Home in Nevada IA, with Elder Rod Simpson officiating. Burial was in the Eden Cemetery, Rhodes IA.

Mrs. Luing was born July 15, 1896 at Maxwell IA to Ulysses Dodd and Mary Day.

She graduated from Collins High School in 1914 and later from Drake University.
