

# Former resident of Collins dies at the age of 41

Lyle (Bill) Luining, former Collins resident, died at Long Beach, Calif. Saturday evening at the age of 41.

Born January 15, 1928 in Collins, he was the son of Lyle and Lota Luining. He had lived in California the past 18 years and was an employee of Douglas Aircraft. His residence was at Los Alamitos.
