Dwight was born April 30, 1913, in Collins, the son of William and Mary (Pence) Luing. He was a graduate of Collins High School. He married Marjorie Clemons in 1934; she died in December 1984. He married Florence E. Wilson on Nov. 27, 1985, in Collins. He owned and operated Farmers Super Market in Collins; he retired in 1979. He moved to Florida 17 years ago. He was a member of Collins Christian Church and enjoyed wood-working and refinishing furniture.

He is survived by one son, Gary Luing and his wife, Sherry, of Lake Wales, Fla.; five grandchildren; and nine great grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wives, Marjorie in December 1984 and Florence on April 12, 1997; one daughter, Sherry A. Schroeder on July 3, 1996; one infant grandson, Kirk Schroeder; one sister, Elsie Robinson; and four brothers, Fred, Lowell, Lyle and Orville Luing.
