### Thomas Gordon Lundy, 83

Thomas Gordon Lundy, 83, Zearing, died of heart failure on Monday, Sept. 9, 2002 at the Story County Hospital in Nevada.

Memorial services were held Saturday, Sept. 14 at the Zearing Christian Church.

Mr. Lundy was a life-long resident of the Zearing area where he farmed all of his life. He retired in 1984. He was also a First Lieutenant in WW II at the Battle of the Bulge.

He was a 1936 graduate of Lincoln Township Consolidated School and a 1947 graduate of the University of Iowa. He was a member of the Zearing Christian Church and also served a church leader.
