Jeanne M. Lively, 82

Mrs. Jeanne M. Lively, 82, formerly of 406 East Main St. in State Center died Friday, Aug. 10, 2001, at the Marshalltown Medical and Surgical Center.

Funeral mass was held at 10 a.m. on Wednesday, Aug. 15, at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in State Center with Father Jon Seda celebrating. Burial followed at the St. Joseph's Cemetery. A memorial fund is being established and may be directed to the family.

She was born in Laramie, Wyoming on Feb. 22, 1919, the daughter of Dan and Marie Dunn MacDonald.

On Feb. 9, 1941, she was united in marriage to Claude Lively at St. Mary's Catholic Church. He preceded her in death in March of 1999.
