Margaret Marie Maliet, 77, of Ames, died Thursday, April 4, at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames from breast cancer.

She was born Feb. 13, 1925, in Zearing, to Charles and Ida (Nagle) Maliet. She graduated from Zearing High School in 1943. She had worked at RH Donnelley Marketing, Ben Franklin Store, Graphic Forms and also helped with patient care with Homeward Hospice for a number of years. She had also cared for her parents and brother, Leonard before their deaths. Margaret was a member of St. Patrick's Catholic Church where she was active and served on many church committees, St. Patrick's Ladies, Nevada VFW Auxiliary, Ames American Legion Post, the Order of the White Shrine of Jerusalem where she was Past Worthy High Priestess, the Order of the Amaranth, the Nevada ABWA and the Nevada Lions Club. She enjoyed traveling and had been in all but one of the states.
