

Raymond T. Malloy, 68

TITUSVILLE, FLA. — Services for Raymond T. Malloy, 68, former Rhodes area resident, died at the hospital in Titusville, Fla. Wednesday morning, Nov. 11, 1987. Services will be held at the chapel of the Estel-Perrin-Avey funeral Home at 10:30 a.m. Monday with Mr. Earl Evans of Des Moines officiating. Burial will be in St. Joseph's Cemetery at Rhodes.

Mr. Malloy was born May 31, 1919 in Rhodes, the son of Tom and Laretta Malloy. He was educated in the Rhodes schools and graduated in 1936. During World War II Mr. Malloy served with the U.S. Marines in the South Pacific. He later was associated with the space center program at White Sands, N.M. and Cape Kennedy at Titusville, Fla. before retiring in 1984.

Survivors include his wife, Rose Carr, whom he married in 1974; a daughter, Sharon (Mrs. Rufus) Garland of Pauls Valley, Okla. a son, Paul of Titusville; a step-son, Jack Lawler of Philadelphia, Pa. Also surviving are three sisters, Grace (Mrs. Lyle) Skinner, Sue (Mrs. George) Worley both of Marshalltown, Jeanne (Mrs. Stanley) Randall of Melbourne, and one brother, Leo Malloy of Rhodes. Preceding him in death were his first wife, Edith Lander, whom he married in 1941, and two sisters.
