Beatrice "Eileen" (Cockerham) Mannes, 84, of Nevada, died of congestive heart failure on Thursday, Oct. 26, at Colonial Manor in Zearing.

She was born in Hubbard on April 2, 1916, to Claude and Nellie (Moore) Manning. She married Lester Cockerham in June of 1933 in Zearing. He preceded her in death.
