Betty (Elizabeth) Margaret Maxwell, 83, of Collins died of heart failure Wednesday afternoon, Dec. 27, at Iowa Lutheran Hospital in Des Moines.

She was born to John and Catherine (Sedey) Tomlonovic on June 9, 1912, at Colfax. She graduated from Colfax High School.

She married Charles Earnest Maxwell on June 3, 1938, in Colfax, and in the same year moved from Jasper County to the rural Collins area. She taught rural school at Lone Rock and Sugar Grove, rural Newton, and was a homemaker. She was a former member of the Sugar Grove Grange and a member of the Immaculate Conception Church.
