He was wounded in the battle at Plieku which was the first major battle on February 5, 1965. He was shuttled back and forth to the United States ending up in Valley Forge Army Hospital where he met Charlotte Baker who was also serving in the Army. They were married March 5, 1966. After leaving the Army they moved back to Eldora where Dave became partners with Guy Baker in the American Freight Agency. In 1988 it was closed mainly due to deregulation of the trucking industry. Dave then drove for Van Wyk trucking until 1993 before driving for Buckeye Coop and Heartland Pork Enterprises and currently Christiansen Farms of Sleepy Eye, MN. He is past worshipful master of Montague Lodge and past worthy patron of the order of the Eastern Star. He was a member of the United Church of Christ Church and the PLCC board of directors and candidate for Mayor of Eldora.
