Georgia Evelyn Rasmussen, 77, of Nevada, died Saturday, May 24, at Mary Greeley Medical Center in Ames.

She was born Feb. 22, 1926, near Fontanelle to Henry and Valeria (Scott) Meisenheimer. She married Arthur Rasmussen on Sept. 23, 1945, in McCallsburg. She graduated from the Oak Park Academy in Nevada in 1944. She had worked at R.H. Donnelley and at the Story County Courthouse for more than 20 years, retiring in 1988. She was a member of Memorial Lutheran Church in Nevada, where she had been the leader of the Esther Circle for many years and served on the board of Lutheran Church Women. She was a former 4-H leader, Girl Scout leader and trainer, a member of the Story County Genealogical Society and the National Campers and Hikers Association. She enjoyed crafts and sewing. She had made many quilt tops for church missions. She also collected and made dolls.

Survivors include her husband, Art, of Nevada; a daughter, LuAnne (and Terry) Pavel of Fort Dodge; and two grandchildren.

Her parents; an infant daughter, Pamela; a brother, Junior Meisenheimer; and a sister, Phyllis Meisenheimer preceded her in death.
