Mrs. Fannie R. Meyer, 75, of Rhodes died of a cerebral hemorrhage Wednesday night at Evangelical Hospital. Services will be at 2 p. m. Saturday at Rhodes Methodist Church with burial in Eden Cemetery.

Mrs. Meyer, born Fannie Beidler May 23, 1881, at Freeport, Ill., came to Marshall County in 1901 and married William T. Meyer Dec. 10, 1902, at Marshalltown. They farmed near Rhodes, retiring and moving into town in 1936. He died last September.

Two sons and three daughters survive: Robert Meyer, Rhodes; Lloyd, Lakewood, Calif.; Mrs. Rosella Bach, Collins; Mrs. Elmer Harre, Laurel, and Mrs. Glen Jackson, Scranton, Ark. Also surviving are 11 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren, two sisters and a brother who live in Illinois.
