Former Maxwell Resident Died

MAXWELL—Mrs. Nettie Myers 71, a former resident here, died Tuesday at her home in Chico, Calif. Dec 3, 1957

Mrs. Myers had returned to her home Sunday after a two-month visit in Maxwell. She arrived in California Tuesday afternoon and died sometime Tuesday night of gas poisoning from a furnace. A granddaughter, Eleanor Ann Thompson, 17, who was in the house, also died of the gas fumes.

Her husband, Dan Myers, a livestock buyer, died in 1952. She moved to California shortly afterward.

Survivors include two sons, Clarence of Paradise, Calif., and Harley of Orion, Ill., and four daughters, Mrs. Velma Stufferbean, Santa Monica, Calif., Mrs. Vesta Cruse, Knoxville, Mrs. Ruth Thompson, Chico, Calif. and Mrs. Elaine Garkick, Monterey, Calif.

The body will be returned to Iowa for funeral services and burial.
