Mrs. Mary Miller died Monday at daughter's home Funeral services held at St. Paul's Lutheran Church Wednesday afternoon

Mrs. Mary Miller, widow of Henry Miller, of this city, died at 12:15 Monday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Christ Schaper, six miles northwest of town, death being due to hardening of the arteries, from which she had suffered all summer. She went to the Schaper home six weeks ago when she became seriously ill and has been bedfast since that time.

Mrs. Miller was born in Hamburg, Germany, February 23, 1859. She married Henry Schultz in Germany and came to America with her husband in 1882. Mr. Schultz died after arriving here and his widow married a second time to Charles Edler. Following Mr. Edler's death, she was married to Henry Miller of this city about twenty-two years ago. Mr. Miller died three years ago in April.

Mrs. Miller is survived by two daughters and three sons. They are Mrs. Christ Schaper, Mrs. Emma Wohlert and Otto and Walter Edler of this city, and Wilbert Edler of Amery, Wisconsin. Two brothers, Wm. and August Sturk, live in Germany. Four sisters also survive, Delia and Augusta in Germany and Mrs. John Kruse of Canada and Mrs. Geo. Nolta of this city. Mrs. Miller is also survived by seventeen grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon at the Christ Schaper home and at 2:00 o'clock from the St. Paul's Lutheran Church here, in charge of Rev. A.H. Schultz. Burial was in Hillside cemetery.
