Poor weather blamed for fatality

The Marshall County Sheriff's Office and the Marshall County Medical Examiner, Dr. David Bethel, are investigating a single vehicle fatality accident that occurred Jan. 28 at 9:30 a.m.

The accident occurred on Hwy. 330 near Melbourne. Preliminary investigation indicates that the weather/road conditions

were a factor in the accident.

The driver, identified as Robert Jay Miller, 36, Waterloo, was southbound on Hwy. 330 when he lost control on the slick roadway and entered the west ditch. The vehicle rolled over coming to rest on its top. He was pronounced dead at the scene.
