Maxine Miller, 84, of Darlington, Ind., and formerly of Ames, died Sunday of heart failure at Lane House Healthcare Center in Crawfordsville, Ind. Graveside services will be at 9 a.m. Friday at Story Memorial Gardens Cemetery, with the Rev. David Digby officiating.
