Shirley Jean Moore, 77, of Yankton, S.D., died Dec. 26 at Avera Sacred Heart Hospital in Yankton from a stroke.

She was born April 26, 1925, to Claude and Ruth (Longacre) Fuller at Milton and spent her childhood on the family farm. She graduated from Milton High School in 1942. She married Herbert F. Moore on Jan. 10, 1946, at Ottumwa. She worked as an office manager and bookkeeper, and she served on many boards and committees, including PTA, the library board, the city council of Cambridge, the board of directors of the Ballard Golf and Country Club and the board of directors of the First State Bank of Huxley and Cambridge. She was a member of Cambridge Methodist Church and served as a leader of the Methodist Youth Fellowship. For several years she was active in Republican Party politics of Story County.

Survivors include her husband Herb; a daughter, Patricia Moore of Lawrence, Kan.; two sons, Mathew (and Laura) Moore of Alamo, Calif., and Bill (and Kelly) of Huxley and six grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her brother, Phil, and a grandson, Khalil.

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Dec. 31, at 1 p.m. at the United Methodist Church in Cambridge. A private burial service will be held for the family at a later date at the Cambridge Cemetery. The Bacon Funeral Home, Maxwell, handled arrangements.
