#### OBITUARY.

Cora May Morrison was born near Mechanicsville, Cedar County, Iowa, March 3, 1870 and died near Rhodes, Iowa, Oct. 21, 1902.

The funeral was held at the M. E. church of Rhodes Thursday, Oct. 23, 1902, 11 a. m.

Deceased was converted when eighteen years of age at the M. E. church of Collins and was a member of that communion until her death.

She leaves a bereaved father and mother, five brothers and two sisters.

For eighteen years she had never been well, although there were times she would seem better. Then our hopes would be blighted, and year by year and day by day she gradually grew weaker and worse, until the

last year, when dropsy set in. On the morning of Oct. 21st, she arose and dressed herself and came downstairs. At eleven o'clock she walked to the lounge, when her mother helped her to lie down. She talked and said "I feel so good, I want to go to sleep." Her mother covered her face with a mosquito bar and went out of the room. In a few minutes she looked and found her sleeping nicely. In about five minutes more she looked and found that Cora was dying. Mother ran out and called father and brother. Cora only lived about twenty minutes.

During the long years of suffering Cora was patient, never complaining.
