

Howard Otto Mosebach

Oct. 23, 1911, to March 12, 2003

Howard Otto Mosebach, 91, of East Moline, Ill., and formerly of Nevada, died Wednesday, March 12, at Forest Hill Health and Rehab Center in East Moline, Ill., where he had been a resident since 2000.

He was born Oct. 23, 1911, in Sheldahl to Otto and Anna (Shonhorst) Mosebach. He attended Sheldahl school. He married Alvina Dueland on Nov. 24, 1938, in Nevada.
