CARROLL FRANCIS "CAP" MOYER, 81

TOLEDO - Carroll Francis "Cap" Moyer, age 81, died Thursday, April 9, 2009, at the Mahaska Hospital in Oskaloosa under the care of Mahaska Hospice. Funeral services were held Tuesday, April 14, 2009 at Kruse-Phillips Funeral Home in Tama. Interment followed at Oak Hill Cemetery in Tama.
