Max D. Nason, age 76 of rural Melbourne, IA, died Tuesday Nov. 25, 2003 at the Villa del Sol Care Center in Marshalltown.

Funeral services were Friday at at the St. John United Church of Christ in Melbourne with Pastor Linda Schmidt officiating. Burial followed at Rose Hill Memorial Gardens. Memorials may be directed to the family.

Max was born November 3, 1927 in Melbourne, to Lenard and Irene Bailey Nason.

Upon his return he began farming, and farmed until retiring in 1992. After retirement he was maintenance supervisor at the Embers in Marshalltown.
