Will Niedert, pioneer resident, passes Sunday April 12, 1962 State Center Enterprise

Will H. Niedert, 87, well known and highly respected resident of the State Center community, passed away at his home Sunday evening, following an illness of several weeks duration. He had been in declining health the past year.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at one-thirty o'clock from the First United Presbyterian church with the Rev. Kenneth R. Pease officiating. Burial was in Hillside cemetery with the Brimhall-West Funeral Home in charge.
