**Mrs. Noble,
Former Area
Woman, Dies**

Mrs. Ida Ahrens Noble, former State Center, Rhodes and Marshalltown resident, died Wednesday at her home in Loveland, Colo.

IDA AHRENS was born Oct. 14, 1880, at State Center, the daughter of Frederick and Lena Reimenschneider Ahrens. She graduated from State Center High School and taught in the rural schools.

On June 3, 1903, she was married to Dr. Lloyd Eugene Noble. They made their home in Rhodes until 1944 when they moved to Marshalltown. One year later they moved to their present home in Loveland.
