Nov. 29, 1922, to Jan. 7, 2002

Paul Fredolph Nordskog, 79, of Nevada, died of brain cancer on Monday, Jan. 7, at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames.

He was born on Nov. 29, 1922, near Story City to Joseph and Martha (Skeie) Nordskog. He was a 1941 graduate of Randall High School. He was a farmer for many years on the Nordskog family farm, and later he bought a farm and moved near Forest City. He married Iva Sampson Nyguard on June 2, 1990, at the Little Brown Church. He was a member of the Memorial Lutheran Church and several bowling leagues. He enjoyed bowling, refinishing antiques and traveling. He had been a resident of Nevada since 1990.

Funeral services were held today, Jan. 10, at Memorial Lutheran Church with Pastors Myron D. Herzberg and Ray Runkel officiating.
