In the early years, she resided in Cedar Rapids and the Berkley, California areas prior to returning to the New Providence area in 1944. She taught for a brief time in New Providence in the late fifties. She was an active member of the Honey Creek-New Providence Friends Church before going to the Eldora Nursing and Rehab Center in 1996. She is survived by her sons Robert (Marilyn) Moon, of Palm Desert, California and Richard (Donna) Moon, of Woodstock, Georgia, five grandchildren; Craig, David, and Mark Moon, Ellen Krogman and Erin Whyte, six great-grandchildren; Ryan and Robert Moon, Lindsay and Alexandra Krogman, and Luc and Brook Whyte. She was preceded in death by her parents, her husband in 1968 and her sister Ruth Meader Foster.
