Stanley H. Olsson, 65, of Tucson, Ariz., died Monday at Tucson Medical Center in Tucson of a ruptured aneurysm. Services will be at 10 a.m. Saturday at St. Cecilia Catholic Church in Ames, with the Rev. Terry Rassmussen officiating. Burial will be in Ames Municipal Cemetery.

Stanley H. Olsson was born Feb. 5, 1936, in Ames, the son of Ernest and Ingeborg (Torvund) Olsson. He lived most of his life in Ames, moving to Tucson in 1993. He served in the U.S. Army from 1954 to 1957. He married Pat Foley Nov. 29, 1958, in Ames. He had worked for the City of Ames and was a CyRide bus driver. He worked as a crossing guard for Tucson Unified School District. He was a member of Our Mother of Sorrows Catholic Church in Tucson.

He is survived by his wife; two sons, Jim Olsson of Nevada and Matt Olsson of Ames; four daughters, Julie Olsson Keigley of Winston Salem, N.C., Carla Turner of Ames, Shelley Rivers of Chandler, Ariz., and Marlene Austin of Ames; 11 grandchildren; one sister, Eleanor Jones of Slater; and two brothers, Richard Olsson of Corvallis, Ore., and Ernest Olsson of Nevis, Minn.

He was preceded in death by his parents; one sister; and one brother.
