Myrtle M. Fisk, 87, of Prophetstown, died Monday, Jan. 1, at the Prophets Riverview Good Samaritan Center.

She was born to Ray and Clara (Skinner) Tiffany in Mingo on June 2, 1908. She graduated from Collins High School in 1926.

She married Ed Osteen on July 16, 1931. He died on Feb. 2, 1935. She then married Karl McDougall on Feb. 14, 1948. He died on April 7, 1952. On Dec. 10, 1965, she married Harold B. Fisk. He died on Sept. 19, 1981.

Myrtle and Ed started a bakery in Prophetstown in October of 1931. Following Ed's passing, she sold the bakery, but continued to work for many years as a retail clerk for several Prophetstown merchants. She was also a member of the First Congregational Church.

Survivors include three step-children, Mary Lois (Mrs. George) Bowen, of Silvis; Marjorie (Mrs. Stan) Moews, of Morrison; and David (Anita) Fisk, of Prophetstown; 11 step-grandchildren; many step-great-grandchildren; several step-great-great-grandchildren; a sister, Alta (Mrs. Clint) Laudner, of Iowa Falls; and nieces and nephews.

Services will be held at 8 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 4, at the Gardner Funeral Home, Prophetstown, with the Rev. M. Melvin Hough, Pastor of the First Congregational Church, officiating.
