Services for Mrs. Luly Bell Minear, 95, who died Saturday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. B. M. Lininger, 135 So. Keeneway dr., will be held at Conger-Morris Funeral home Tuesday at 1:30 p.m. The Rev. Escil Hiser of the Church of the Brethren will officiate. Interment will be in the Brethren cemetery at Talent.

Mrs. Minear was born Dec. 4, 1863, in Oregon, Ill., and was married Oct. 13, 1885, at Maxwell, Ia., to Lorenzo D. Minear, who preceded her in death in December, 1907.

They moved to Medford in September, 1898, living near what is now Minear rd. and South Stage rd. She made her home with her daughter, Mrs. Lininger, Ashland, from 1926 to 1942, when they moved to Medford, residing here until her death. Mrs. Minear became a member of the Church of the Brethren in 1879.
