MINGO — Leo Pohlman, 87, formerly of Mingo, died Saturday, August 23, 2008 at University Hospitals and Clinics in Iowa City.

Leo was born December 26, 1920 at Castana, Iowa, the son of John and Margaret (Lindsey) Pohlman. He was united in marriage to Frieda Dahl on July 17, 1942. Frieda preceded Leo in death on October 24, 1990. Leo farmed near Mingo, Iowa from 1955 until retiring in 2002. He was a member of the Ira United Christian Church.
