## Melbourne, Dies

Ora Alfred Pyle, 77, Melbourne, died at 7 a. m. Wednesday at Evangelical Hospital, where he had been since Saturday. He retired from farming in 1951 following a stroke but remained on the farm southwest of Melbourne where he had lived since childhood.

Services will be at 2 p. m. Saturday at Melbourne Methodist Church with burial in Restland Cemetery, Baxter. Friends may call at the Boyd-Nickel Funeral Home in Baxter.

Mr. Pyle, son of John B. and Anna Pyle, was born near Laurel Nov. 2, 1878. He was married Jan. 1, 1902, to Mary Floy Jontz, who died in 1946. Their daughter died the same year.
