

Mrs. Rosa Reinschmidt

Funeral Monday ^{Mar} 1949

Rosa Della Sperling Reinschmidt passed away at her home in Rhodes at 10:30 Friday morning following a long illness. She was born August 1, 1875 on a farm in Jasper county near Valeria, a twin daughter of John and Elizabeth (Barker) Sperling and is the last of her family. She married Jacob Frederick Reinschmidt April 2, 1897, at Newton and they made their home on a farm 8 miles south of Rhodes until September 1920, when they moved to Rhodes. She had always lived in and around Jasper, Polk and Marshall counties.

Mr. Reinschmidt died in 1944, a brother, Isaac Adam Sperling, in July 1935, and a sister, Anna, December 1, 1947. Two sisters died in infancy. Two children also preceded her in death. Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Eva Stier, of Rhodes, and a cousin, W. F. McDivitt of Des Moines.

Services were held Monday at 1:30 p.m. at the Latter Day Saints church in Rhodes in charge of Elder Charles Lehman of Colo. A mixed quartette was composed of Mrs. Allen Tribby, Mrs. Russell Buck, David Buck and Luther Hix. They were accompanied by Miss Agnes Buck. Flower bearers were Mrs. Denzel Richeson and Mrs. Maynard Jackson. Pall bearers were Leland Alexander, Russell Buck, Charles Elliott, Alva Hoy, James Gray and Denzel Richeson.

Burial was in Peoria cemetery near Maxwell.
