A new ultraviolet ray machine has been added by Dr. L.F. Richardson to the electrical equipment of his office. Before the installation of the new unit, Dr. Richardson has had in operation a high frequency electrical outfit, an X-ray machine and other electrical devices. The addition of the ultraviolet ray makes his equipment along this line practically complete for the diagnosis and treatment of various diseases.

For a long time it has been unnecessary to go to the big city for x-rays and violet ray treatments, the same results being obtainable right here in Collins, and now as a result of the widespread use of ultraviolet therapy, this new device has been installed so that people of this section have the advantage of practically every electrical outfit that is used in the big hospitals and city clinics, both for treatment and diagnosis.
