

Mrs. Richeson Dies At Age 91

Mrs. Bessie Richeson, 91, formerly of Rhodes, dies Sunday morning at the Colonial Manor in Zearing. Services are set for Wednesday at 11 a.m. from the Pursel-Davis Funeral Home, with burial following in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens.

Born July 22, 1894, in Rhodes, she was the daughter of Ralph and Priscilla Coulter Sanders. She was married to Otto Richeson on March 11, 1910, in Story County; he preceded her in death in 1959.

One son, Robert E. Richeson of Rhodes, survives. There are nine grandchildren, 19 great-grandchildren and 13 great-great-grandchildren. Mrs. Richeson was preceded in death by her husband, two sons and a granddaughter.
