Larkin C. Richeson, aged 52, one of the older residents of the county, died at his home, 108½ West Linn street, Sunday at midnight, after an illness of four weeks with typhoid fever. He was taken sick in State Center, and three weeks ago came to his home in this city, since which time his condition has been serious. He was a veterinary surgeon, having practiced for several years in State Center.

Larkin C. Richeson was born in Clark county, Ohio, Sept. 26, 1851, and removed to Marshall county, settling near State Center, in 1866. On June 17, 1877, he was united in marriage to Miss Lydia Fike, of Rhodes. They removed to State Center, but during the past few years the mother and family have been residing in this city, Mr. Richeson retaining his practice at State Center. He is survived by his wife, three sons, Lester, Forest and Gaylord, and two daughters, Mrs. Nellie Richeson, and Miss Kezia, all of this city. The funeral services will be held at the home Wednesday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Rev. F. M. Coleman officiating. The interment will be in Riverside.
