

Otto Richeson Dies Friday; Rites Monday

MELBOURNE — (Special) — Otto E. Richeson, 67, a lifelong resident of the Rhodes community, died Friday evening at Evangelical Hospital in Marshalltown.

THE BODY is at the Ryan Funeral Home where it will remain until 10 a.m. Monday. Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Monday at the Reorganized Church of Latter Day Saints in Rhodes with Elder V. E. Lents in charge. Burial will be in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens near Marshalltown.

Mr. Richeson was born near Rhodes July 2, 1891, one of nine children of George and Belle Richeson. On March 10, 1910, he was married to Bessie Sanders who survives with three sons, Charles Howard and Ralph W. of Marshalltown and Robert E. of Rhodes.
