

William D. Richeson

William D. Richeson, 76 years old, 618 Eighteenth avenue, East Moline, died in a local hospital about 7:20 o'clock last night after a short illness of bronchial pneumonia. He had been in the hospital only a few days.

Mr. Richeson was born in Abingdon, Ill., July 22, 1857. He had been a resident of East Moline about twenty-five years. He was a carpenter by trade. His wife preceded him in death several years. Survivors are a daughter, Mrs. Emma Batesol of Marshalltown, Iowa, and four sons, Jasper of Grinnell, Iowa, William of Moline, M. J. Richeson of Rock Island and Earl of Waterloo.

Funeral services will be at 3:30 o'clock tomorrow afternoon in the Wendt Bros. funeral home, East Moline. The Rev. Norman Rostrom, pastor of the First Methodist Episcopal church, East Moline, will officiate. The body will be taken to Rhodes, Iowa, where services will be conducted Thursday afternoon, with burial in the Rhodes cemetery.
