

## Martin H. Richeson, 79

STATE CENTER — Funeral services for Martin H. Richeson, 79, of State Center, were held Monday morning at the Rhodes United Methodist Church with the Rev. Beverlee Bell officiating. Burial was in the Eden Cemetery. *24 AUG 1990*
