

## FORMER RHODES WOMAN DEAD.

Mrs. William Bullock Dies at York, Neb., and is Buried at Rhodes.

Mrs. William Bullock, a former Rhodes woman, died at York, Neb., Sunday of typhoid fever. Her body reached Rhodes this forenoon, and the funeral was held this afternoon. Burial was in the Rhodes cemetery.

Mrs. Bullock was 64 years of age. She was a daughter of one of the pioneer families of the neighborhood between Rhodes and State Center. Her maiden name was Pheobe Anna Richeson, and her parents, both of whom are now dead, were Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Richeson.

Mrs. Bullock had been married three times. Her first husband was Jacob Sharp, who was killed on the Northwestern near State Center. She later married David Bullock, who died. Her third husband was William Bullock nephew of David Bullock. Her husband survives her, as do two sons, Edson Sharp of her first marriage, and Willard Bullock of the second. Mr. Sharp lives at Fairmont, Neb., and Mr. Bullock resides at York, Neb. Three brothers and one sister also survive Mrs. Bullock. They are D. W. Richeson, of Moline, Ill.; George E. Richeson, of Rhodes; Martin Richeson, of State Center; and Mrs. W. H. Batesole, of this city.
