Pat Riemenschneider longtime resident passes Sunday December 9, 1948 State Center Enterprise

William (Pat) Riemenschneider, well known resident of this community passed away Sunday afternoon at the St. Thomas Mercy hospital in Marshalltown where he had been confined for the past three weeks. Mr. Riemenschneider had been in declining health for about a year.

Funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at the Wensel Funeral Home at 1:30 p.m. and at St. Paul Lutheran Church at 2:00 p.m. with the Rev. Elmer J. Braun officiating.
