

Howard H. Riemenschneider, 78

STATE CENTER — Funeral services for Howard H. Riemenschneider, 78; of State Center, who died Thursday morning, Sept. 15, at his home, will be held at St. Joseph's Catholic Church in State Center at 10 a.m. Monday with the Rev.
