### Heart attack is fatal to James Rock

James Rock, 62, who has been in the barbering business here since 1942, died at St. Thomas hospital in Marshalltown last Saturday afternoon. He had suffered a heart attack the preceding Wednesday but was reported to be improved last Friday night. A second attack early last Saturday morning caused his death.

Mr. Rock was born March 19, 1889, at Kansas City, MO, the son of John and Ella Welch Rock. He grew up at Kansas City and attended school in that city.

He was married to Miss Flora Minear at Kansas City May 20, 1918 and following their marriage, they moved to Maxwell. He enlisted in the U.S. Army on July 25, 1918 and served overseas in World War I. He was honorably discharged April 24, 1919.

He is survived by his wife, one daughter, Joyce of State Center, and two sons, James Jr. of Clear Lake and Harlan of Marshalltown. He is also survived by three grandchildren, a step mother, three half sisters and four half brothers.
