

C.L. Sanders Dies At 70

C. L. (Porky) Sanders, 70, 401 N. 13th Ave., died Wednesday evening at Marshalltown Area Community Hospital. Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Saturday at the Pursel-Davis Chapel, the Rev. Weldon Whitenack in charge. Burial will be in Rose Hill Memorial Gardens.

He was born Nov. 2, 1913, at Ira, the son of Samuel Claud and Artie Clementine Evans Sanders.

He spent his early life and received his education at Rhodes and moved to Marshalltown in 1942.

He was married to Helen Gronwoldt Jan. 26, 1939, at State Center. She preceded him in death in 1979.

Surviving are two daughters, Karen (Mrs. L. J.) Shipley, Green Mountain, and Irene (Mrs. Larry) Pieters, Marshalltown; one son, Frederick Sanders, Marshalltown, 17 grandchildren and two great-grandchildren.
