David John Sandquist, 88, of Maxwell, died Jan. 29, at the Israel Family Hospice House in Ames from congestive heart failure.

He was born June 28, 1913, in Ankeny to George and Martha Sandquist. He graduated from Ankeny High School. He married Lorraine Hutton on Aug. 13, 1938, in Indianola, and they lived on a farm in the Maxwell and Cambridge area from 1939 to 1978, when they moved into Maxwell. Farming was David's love and passion. He started the family farm in 1939 and along with his son, Kenneth, continued to farm until a few months ago. He was a member of the Loring United Methodist Church and the Masonic Lodge in Maxwell. He enjoyed playing horseshoes, reading and spending time with his family, especially his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

Survivors include four children, Martha Brown of Watertown, N.Y., John Sandquist of Urbandale, Kenneth Sandquist of Cambridge and Cindy Goertz of White Bear, Minn.; nine grandchildren; and seven great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his wife, Lorraine on March 6, 1996; four brothers; and two sisters.
